## THIS IS A POLITICALLY ACTIVE HOUSEHOLD. IF THE POLICE VISIT YOU OR YOUR FAMILY:

- remain calm and measured
- provide your name and address if asked
- ask for the police officers' names, identity numbers, ranks, and station
- ask the police to explain what they want
- ask them if they have a warrant. If they do, check the date and what it allows them to do
- contact a lawyer or legal support immediately
- ask the police if they are recording the interaction
- let the police know you are recording the interaction on your phone or write down everything that happens as soon as possible

- you do not have to answer any of their questions
- you do not need to let them inside if they don't have a warrant
- you do not have to return police phone calls
- you do not have to go anywhere with them unless they have a detention warrant or arrest you
- if the police are asking you about a family member or someone who no longer lives at your house, you are not required to give them any information about that person
- do not lie or give false information
